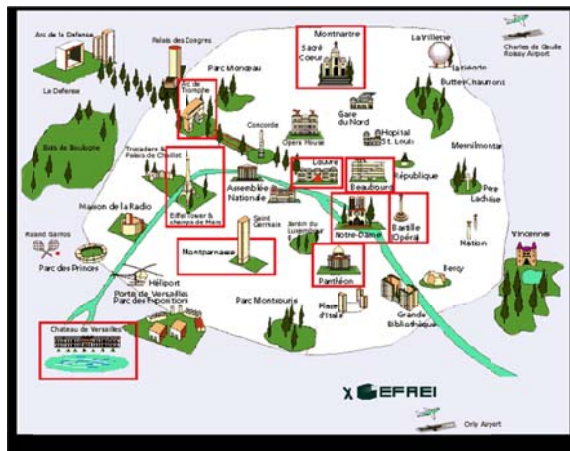
## 2. Where will you sleep?
